RESOLUTION NO. RE2024-003 RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF MILFORD, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY FIXING THE RATE OF INTEREST TO BE CHARGED ON DELINQUENT TAXES OF ASSESSMENTS.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:4-67 permits the governing body of each municipality to fix the rate of interest to be charged for non-payment of taxes or assessment subject to any abatement or discount for the late payment of taxes as proved by law; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:4-67 has been amended to permit the fixing of said rate of 8% per annum on the first \$1,500.00 of the delinquency and 18% per annum on any amount in excess of \$1,500.00 and allows an additional penalty of 6% be collected against a delinquency in excess of \$10,000.00 on properties that fail to pay the delinquency prior to the end of the calendar year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the Borough of Milford, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- The Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to charge 8% per annum on the first \$1,500.00 of taxes becoming delinquent after the due date and 18% per annum on any amount of taxes in excess of \$1,500.00 becoming delinquent after the due date and if a delinquency is in excess of \$10,000.00 and remains in arrears beyond December 31st, an additional penalty of 6% shall be charged against the delinquency. Effective January 1, 2024 there will be a ten (10) day grace period of quarterly tax payments made by cash, check or money order.
- 2. Any payments not made in accordance with paragraph two of this resolution shall be charged interest from the due date as set forth in paragraph one of this resolution.
- 3. A certified copy of this resolution shall be provided by the Borough Clerk to the Tax Collector, the Borough Attorney and Borough Auditor for the Borough of Milford.
